To Whom It May Concern:

This letter confirms the acceptance of the **NSF-U.P.Code Mark** and **cNSF Mark**.

NSF-U.P.Code Mark

The NSF-U.P.Code Mark demonstrates product certification to the Uniform Plumbing Code. NSF's U.P.Code Mark is accepted in all jurisdictions using the Uniform Plumbing Code. The Uniform Plumbing Code does not require products to be listed by the International Association of Plumbing and Mechanical Officials (IAPMO), nor does it require the UPC shield on the product. Products certified to the Uniform Plumbing Code will bear a footnote in the NSF Official Listing stating, "§ Product is Certified to the Uniform Plumbing Code."

Section 301.1.1 of the Uniform Plumbing Code requires plumbing products to be listed or labeled by an approved listing agency and to conform to applicable, recognized standards. Applicable standards are listed in Table 14-1 of the Uniform Plumbing Code. NSF International meets the requirements as a Listing Agency defined in the Uniform Plumbing Code Section 214.0. NSF's marking requirements include the standard reference as well as the NSF Mark with designation U.P.Code.

cNSF Mark

NSF's Canadian Certification Program is accredited by the Standards Council of Canada and is accepted by all Canadian Provinces. In the link provided, you will find a reference from the National Plumbing Code of Canada 2005 indicating that NSF is an [accredited certification agency](#). For products meeting Canadian requirements, marking includes a "c" in the eight o'clock position of the NSF Mark.

NSF has created a Regulatory Affairs Hotline **1-877-867-3435**. This hotline serves a dual purpose. The hotline assists regulators with questions about certification issues. More importantly, the hotline is a central call center for product acceptance issues. If the acceptability of a product is ever questioned in the field due to a certification issue, NSF has a network of experienced professionals to quickly resolve any issues.

NSF is a member of the International Association of Plumbing and Mechanical Officials, the International Code Council, the Canadian Advisory Council on Plumbing and the Federal, Provincial, Territorial Committee on Drinking Water. NSF is an IAPMO and ASSE approved testing agency, and is accredited by the International Accreditation Service, the American National Standards Institute, and Standards Council of Canada as a testing and listing agency.
