Background:

Historically, the USDA was the government agency charged with establishing the proprietary substances and nonfood compounds program in the U.S. meat and poultry sector. The USDA discontinued the program in 1998, further advancing its position shift, from prescriptive regulation to performance-based reviews.

By taking lead from the USDA framework, NSF was able to develop a streamlined registration program that continues to satisfy the risk management needs of product manufacturers, food processors, and regulators.
