**NSF AUDIT APPLICATION FORM FOR THERMOSTATIC MIXING VALVE SCHEMES  
TMV 2 & TMV 3**

Thermostatic mixing valves approved under the TMV2 and TMV3 Schemes are required to undergo mechanical audit testing to ensure that the approved valve continues to comply with the performance requirements of each scheme.

- TMV2 valves are required to be audit tested once within the 5 year licence period.
- TMV3 valves are required to be audit tested twice within the 5 year licence period.

The licence holder will be notified when audit testing of their thermostatic mixing valve is required, the license holder must then liaise with the test houses to undertake the audit testing.

To ensure that the audit testing is undertaken in a satisfactory manner this application form must be completed and returned to NSF.

NSF will then issue the licence holder with a NSF reference number that must be used when corresponding with the test house upon audit testing. NSF will also detail the sample selection process as well as the exact valve to be tested and the tests to be performed as part of the performance audit.

NSF **must** be informed of all audit testing failures and be provided with a full set of test results as detailed in the audit procedure document that can be found on the NSF website [www.nsf.org](http://www.nsf.org).

NSF must be supplied with the audited valve for retention by the Scheme.
